
On behalf of the Commonwealth of Virginia, congratulations to Toastmasters International on your 100th anniversary. What an amazing achievement!


Happy 100th Birthday, Toastmasters!

She is a charter member of AT&T Middletown Toastmasters and has served in many district leadership positions. As Lieutenant Governor of Marketing, she helped charter 27 clubs and was awarded the "Excellence in Marketing" award. She is a Distinguished Past District Governor of District 46, which included metropolitan New York and New Jersey. It was one of the largest districts in the world, with over 250 clubs and over 4,500 members. Toastmasters International President Jana Barnhill awarded her a Presidential Citation in August of 2009. She was honored to serve on the very first International Leadership Committee.

Additionally, she spoke on a Leadership Panel titled "Achieving Success in the Distinguished District" during the 2009 Toastmasters International Convention. She was appointed as Region 9 Advisor in 2015 -2016 and served as an International Director from 2017 to 2019.

Outside of Toastmasters, Radhi has worked in the telecommunications industry for over 30 years. She is an electrical engineer working for AT&T in Middletown, NJ. She has expertise in software development, systems administration, and acceptance testing. She troubleshoots problems and develops software for projects that impact millions of people.

She has two daughters and lives with her husband in Piscataway, NJ.



About the Dancers

About the dance teacher: Dr. Bharati Khopkar: received a rigorous training for 12 years from various teachers from Pune, India. Started her training from a tender age of 9 and completed her graduation in Kathak in 1981. On the flip side, awarded a PhD in Applied Chemistry from Japan in 1997.

About Kathak: We all may know that, Kathak has originated from North India. Katha kahe so kathak kehelaye. A story teller interpreted his story with the help of hand gestures and foot sounds. Breath taking speed, flawless spins and complex rigorous footwork are most important elements of this dance form.

Today's performance: My students will be performing classical SARAGAM (vocal notes) and CHATURANG (4 colors of this dance form rhythmic pieces, vocal notes, Tarana the rhythmic patterns, and expressions) as viewed from Kathak lens.
